This trip has been very inspiring. Highlights include:



Graduations and exams: We enjoyed the graduation ceremony for kindergarten students moving up to primary school and our Grade 12 students completing their final year. National exams for Grade 12 and regional exams for Grade 8 have been taken — we're now eagerly awaiting the results!



Catching up after conflict:

After more than two years of accelerated learning, students and teachers have successfully made up for the time lost during the war. Children are now at the appropriate age for their grade. This summer, we're excited to reintroduce clubs and extracurricular activities to help them thrive beyond the classroom.



Vocational training returns: Vocational courses have restarted with great success. Our first cohort of cooking students has graduated, and a new group is already mid-programme. We have also launched several IT training courses. Both these courses are enriched by entrepreneurship workshops led by a local training partner.



Summer school: despite the great progress we have made in education, some students are still struggling with their classes. To help the students, they are required to attend 6 weeks of summer school during the holidays. The classes are mornings only and alternate days with home study to complete in between.
